#### Director's Notes...

Since it's original production in 1996, *Ragtime* rose to the top of my list of favorite musicals due to it's fascinating intersection of real-life historical figures and fictionalized characters that so beautifully and heartbreakingly depict the timeless struggle for acceptance, understanding, and justice faced particularly by the people of color and women that comprise the backbone of our nation's fabric. It is a real honor to be working on this production at this time, at this theatre where I got my directorial start, and with this team of amazing collaborators.

Ragtime presents a cross-section of the American experience from the perspectives of 3 families, all pursuing their idea of the American dream. When the privileged and sheltered world of an affluent white family from New Rochelle collides with those of a Black family from Harlem and a Jewish family who have just immigrated from Latvia, in the melting pot of turn-of-the-century America, their minds and hearts are compelled to awaken to the injustices and prejudices experienced by people of other races and backgrounds. They are challenged to get to know people who are different than they are and to turn that new awareness into action.

This production and this material have been a delightful challenge for our cast and creative team, and we hope that it will challenge our audiences to find the parallels between the lives of these characters and lives of Americans in our modern world, and to be inspired to reach out and get to know individuals that come from backgrounds and cultures that differ from their own.

Thank you so much for attending our production! We hope it will move you, as much as it has us!

very excited to be back with the Athens family, and her creative roots. She also wants to thank her family for the constant love and encouragement.




