

Director's Notes...

"All the reading she had done had given her a view of life that [her family] had never seen." -Roald Dahl, *Matilda*.


I was around 7 years old when I first read Roald Dahl's *Matilda*. I loved books and reading from a very young age, and voraciously read everything I could get my hands on. I made up and wrote my own stories and escaped into the adventures and worlds that books provided. And, like Matilda, I sometimes felt very alone and different from the people around me. But when I found her, I found a kindred spirit and realized a truth that Dahl so aptly describes in his novel: "So Matilda's strong young mind continued to grow, nurtured by the voices of all those authors who had sent their books out into the world like ships on the sea. These books gave Matilda a hopeful and comforting message: You are not alone." It was a message that I've carried with me into adulthood, and one that is woven into Matilda's story. *Matilda* also taught me that "just because you find that life's not fair, it doesn't mean that you just have to grin and bear it..." It's another powerful message throughout the show that resonated with me as a child, and one that I think is so important and especially powerful today. The idea that you can "change your

story," that no matter how big or small you are, no matter where you come from, or how other people perceive you, you have the power to change the world. That power and magic reside inside of you, and you are responsible for how your story ends. And no matter how small or powerless you feel, with bravery (and the help of friends), you CAN make a difference. I hope that audiences walk away remembering that you can "change the story," that you are not alone, and sometimes it's okay to "be a little bit naughty."

Matilda was originally a book written by Roald Dahl. Best known for being a prolific children's author (with famous works like *James and the Giant Peach, Charlie and the Chocolate Factory, Matilda*, and many more), his body of work draws largely from his lived experiences. Many characters and themes in his books (and especially in *Matilda*) can be traced back to the strict schools and strange experiences of his childhood.

Dahl lost his father at a young age and his mother sent him to a series of strict boarding schools. In these settings Dahl rebelled and became known as boisterous and untamed. Disenchanted with school. Years later, when asked, his daughter stated that her father's novel was, in part, about his love for books: "I think that there was a deep genuine fear within his heart that books were going to go away and he wanted to write about it." (Thank goodness he did!)




