



In the spring of 1996, I witnessed a show that would deeply influence my journey in live theatre: RENT. RENT showcased diversity and illuminated the very human side of the HIV/AIDS crisis, depression, and drug addiction. It allowed the world to delve into the experiences of those affected by these issues through the lens of human emotion, conveyed by the poignant and powerful lyrics and music of the late Jonathan Larson, whose untimely death before the Broadway premiere sent shockwayes through the arts community.

As someone who grew up in the NYC area, an aspiring artist, a member of the LGBTO+ community, and of Puerto Rican descent, I finally found a show where I could see myself, my friends, and my loved ones—some of whom were taken too early by the HIV/AIDS epidemic represented on stage. This moment sparked the inspiration that shapes who I am today.

It has always been my dream to be a part of or present *RENT* in some form. Today, that dream has become reality, and I am honored and privileged to present *RENT* at the Athens Theatre as the director of this show. This project is supported by an incredible creative team including Kim Ball (Choreographer), Chris Endsley (Music Director), and Jarrett Poore (Intimacy Choreographer), and we have assembled one of the most talented casts ever seen on the Athens stage, with support from dedicated designers, crew, staff, and a live band.

What you are about to experience on stage today is a project approached with empathy, humility, and compassion, with the intention of challenging any preconceived notions and leaving our theatre having immersed yourself in a sea of unity and understanding.

I extend my heartfelt gratitude for attending our entire 2023/2024 season, but above all, for joining us on this journey today to 1989 in the Lower East Side of New York City to witness the essence of community-love.

The writer and creator of *RENT*, Jonathan Larson's creative journey with the musical began when he collaborated with friend Billy Aronson, who initially conceived the idea of a modern adaptation of the opera *La Bohème*. Larson's passion

for the project led him to work tirelessly on it while juggling odd jobs, such as waiting tables at the Moondance Diner. Despite setbacks and the eventual parting of ways with Aronson, Larson poured his soul into completing the musical, drawing inspiration from his own life experiences, including his time living in a SoHo apartment with his best friend Jonathan Burkhart.

Tragically, Larson's health issues began to escalate during the final rehearsals for *RENT* culminating in his sudden passing due to an aortic dissection believed to have been caused by undiagnosed Marfan syndrome the night before its Off-Broadway premiere. Despite the shock and grief, the cast and crew persevered, honoring Larson's memory with a legendary first performance dedicated to him. The success of the production led to a Broadway transfer, where *RENT* received critical acclaim and earned Larson three posthumous Tony Awards and the Pulitzer Prize for Drama, solidifying his place in theatrical history.

Larson's impact extends beyond his contributions to the stage, as evidenced by the establishment of the Jonathan Larson Performing Arts Foundation, which continues to support aspiring artists in his memory. His music, including iconic songs like *La Vie Bohème* and *Seasons of Love*, remains beloved by fans worldwide, serving as anthems of hope and resilience. Through his enduring legacy, Larson's message of seizing the moment and embracing love lives on, inspiring future generations to create, innovate, and cherish each day.
